CARING FOR THE EARTH - Drinking Water: When you want a drink of water, what do you reach for—a plastic water bottle or a glass and the nearest faucet? Some facts to keep in mind--The production and transportation of a 1-liter water bottle uses 6.74 gallons of water and a liter of fossil fuel and is responsible for the emission of 1.2 lb. of greenhouse gases. Nearly 90 percent of water bottles are not recycled and wind up in landfills. Because the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's standards for tap water are more stringent than the Food and Drug Administration's standards for bottled water, tap water is just as safe as, or safer than, bottled.
