**Caring for the Earth: Gardenin Pesticide Free:** You can control pests in your garden naturally. Weeds and wildflowers nurture a host of critters, so leave a few patches in your yard. You can also use logs, hedges and leaf piles to provide cover. Growing companion plants can keep pests away from your vegetables—for example, nasturtiums lure caterpillars away from salad greens. Birds also control pests, and bird feeders will make them want to stay. Good soil, crop rotation, and careful watering also lead to healthy, pest-resistant plants.
