Caring For The Earth: Green Grilling Outdoor grilling is a summer rite of passage around here. Fourth of July is the biggest grilling day of the year. It has been estimated that the barbecues held on the Fourth of July consume enough energy to power 20,000 households for a year. Your choice of grill can make a difference. The cleanest type of grill for the environment is gas. Wood and charcoal grills produce clouds of sooty particles that can irritate respiratory problems. Carcinogenic compounds like benzene are released. By comparison, gas burns cleaner and more efficiently and isn't as bad for air quality as wood and charcoal grills.
